The year six students used the opportunity to continue working outdoors in the natural environment. In small groups they gathered objects and pieces from around the farm and used them to construct their group 'mandalas'. These wonderful art pieces demonstrate the cycle of life.

The vegetable patch had a clean up after the holiday break, which will assist with the production of the last seasonal produce before students begin raising seedlings in the green house and discover options for winter planting.

Students also looked at the relationship between predators and prey by looking at the diet of the masked owl and how its presence on the farm can assist in maintaining a healthy environment.

WHAT IS BMX?


