I would like to welcome all students. staff and families to the 2020 academic year.


Over the break, work has been completed on the new Senior School Centre at Maddingley. The new senior facilities are a improvement on what was previously available. The building is already in use and the reaction of students to their new surroundings has been pleasing. Landscaping of what is now a large central quadrangle for the Senior School will begin in the near future.

I have had a significant number of members of the school community and broader community telephoning me with concerns about reports that contaminated soil is to be relocated to Bacchus Marsh. It is our understanding that a decision on this matter is yet to be made. The reports, if true, are part of a worrying trend for Governments of all levels to see this town, and the west in general, through a lens of waste disposal and centres for that green-washed phrase 'resource recovery'.

We have made our concerns on these matters known and will continue to argue for a land-use decision which is fair for the School and place urban amenity at the forefront of considerations.

I would ask that any individual or family who has travelled to China, Hong Kong or Taiwan in the last two weeks to contact the school to discuss their situation. Equally, if someone who is staying with you has been in these areas, or if you have come in contact with someone suffering from Novel Coronavirus directly or indirectly, please make contact with the school to discuss their circumstances.

Student Wellbeing

Bushfire events over the holidays have been confronting for the whole community. For some children this may be the first time they have been exposed to a disaster on this scale. There are several resources for parents wishing to assist their children to process recent events and to reassure them about the future. The following steps are recommended by plan.org as an approach to dealing with commonly expressed concerns by children in times of crisis.

- 1. Let them know that whatever they are feeling is okay
- Reassure your children
- 3. Help your children know they, and others, won't be alone
- 4. Discuss what if this happens to us?
- 5. Keep up to date with weather and warnings
- 6. Make sure your children know vital information
- 7. Help them find ways to help

Helping others empowers all of us, including children, to gain control over our response to difficult events. In addition, limiting exposure to media coverage is an important measure to take when media saturation can heighten anxiety and feelings of vulnerability. School Information

Exclusion from Multimedia

The School is active in photography and videography within the school grounds and when recording key assemblies, activities, camps and excursions throughout the year. These forms of multimedia* are utilised to communicate to our School Community main achievements, notable news and events, via our weekly newsletter, website blogs, Yearbook and minimally via social media and advertising.

*Multimedia is defined as photography, video, audio or any other form of electronic recording.

It is important that the School is aware of any students who are not permitted to have their photograph or any video footage feature in these forms of communication.

The School has developed a key exclusion from multimedia listing for 2020 based on parents' response to relevant sections of the Acknowledgment of Business Notice and policies sent by the Principal in November 2019.

If parents would like to register their child/ren on the 'Exclusion from Multimedia' listing for 2020, it is important that you do so by Friday 14 February by completing the <u>relevant form</u> and returning it to the Main Administration office or scanning and emailing it to school@bmg.vic.edu.au.

Important Private Bus Information

CCTV on Buses

Effective 2020, CCTV is fitted on all private BMG school bus services and will be operational. They will record from stop 1 to school in the AM and school to the last stop in the PM. The footage will be kept for seven days, after seven days the footage will be deleted. The footage will be sent on request to BMG. The footage is time sequenced and record the rear saloon of the bus and drivers cabin area. Should you require any further information on this further safety procedure please feel free to email the bus co-ordinator.

AM Drop off

Parents and students are advised to be at their designated pick up stop a minimum of 5 minutes prior to their departure time listed on their route timetable.

PM Pick up

Our drivers are instructed not to allow primary aged students to exit buses unless there is a parent or guardian to receive them at the bus door.

Permission Tags

Parents of Year 5 and 6 students may provide written permission for their child to exit the bus without a parent/guardian to collect them and for them to take responsibility for their younger siblings. Students in Prep to Year 4 must have a Parent/Guardian at the stop for collection. If a parent is not there to collect their child, the driver will call our Operations Team who will contact the School. The School will then contact the parents regarding a pick up location. If a parent is uncontactable, the child will remain in the driver's care and will be taken back to the bus depot to await collection. Parents of students in Prep to Year 4 may nominate an additional person to collect their child from the bus by completing a Junior School Permission form and emailing to bus@bmg.vic.edu.au located on the Parent Portal. This, in turn, will have a green permission tag placed on the student's bag advising the driver who has permission to collect the child/ren from the bus.

2019 Permission tags will be removed from the students' bags on 21 February 2020. If you require your child to disembark to be met by someone other than the parent/guardian an updated permission tag must be completed for 2020.

Parking

It is recommended that parents pull off the road into a service road or designated car park (where possible) whilst dropping off and picking up their children. Parents need to be mindful not to park their cars in the way of a bus and ensure that the bus has enough space to safely drive into and pull out of the stopping area. Also, as there are bus stops in residential areas, it is important that parents do not park in, or across, residential driveways and always respect residents' property.

Roll Call

By now, all parents would have received a 'Welcome' email from Roll Call. We advise parents to activate their account so they have live tracking of the bus and notification that their child has taped on/off the bus.

Woodlea Late Bus

The Woodlea Late Bus is available on Tuesday afternoons, but only for students who are participating in the Middle School Production or attending after school curriculum classes. Students are to sign up on the late bus register prior to 1.30pm in the Main Administration office. Please note that the <u>Late Bus</u> is a limited stop service.

A reminder that parents should:

- Drop off or wait for their child on the same side of the road as the bus stop.
- Park away from the designated bus stop area.
- Not approach students, other parents or the bus driver.
- Under no circumstances board the bus.

Conveyance Allowance

Following a recent decision by the Student Transport Unit of the Education Department, it appears that there may be some movement on the way the Department makes a judgement on what is the nearest appropriate school. This comes after considerable work by the School on your behalf.

If your decision to send your children to Bacchus Marsh Grammar was because you felt that it was the nearest appropriate school that respected ecumenical values but did not require your child to participate in religious instruction or religious celebrations, then you may (subject to other Conveyance Allowance rules) be eligible for the Conveyance Allowance.

If this statement applies to you, whilst I can make no guarantees, I believe it is in your interests to submit a Conveyance Allowance Application for 2020. The application should be accompanied by a simple letter stating the reasons why you believe Bacchus Marsh Grammar is the nearest appropriate school because of its values and its lack of a requirement to participate in religious instruction or religious celebrations of any particular faith.

Please ensure that you complete the form that applies to your child's travel. Forms are available from the main office at both the Woodlea and Maddingley campus. Please be aware that no allowance is payable if the journey to and from school can be made using a free bus service.


