School Administration Information

Maddingley Car Park

The school provides a significant car park for parents and others. The carpark is staffed and controlled at a level that is not seen at many schools. The car park still, however, requires the common sense and cooperation of all users if it is to operate efficiently.

There are dedicated zones designed for quick drop off or pick up and is not to be used for extended parking. There are special arrangements in place between 2.45pm and 3.05pm for Prep to Year 2. We also remind parents that there is no drop off or pick up on South Maddingley Road.

The parking conditions which are not onerous are designed for the safety of students and ease of access for all. We ask parents to be mindful of their behaviours in the car park and be patient.

Woodlea Drop Off/Pick Up Arrangements

Firstly, thank you for your patience throughout the trial period of drop offs and pick ups on Timbertop Avenue. The process is constantly under review and alterations will be made if and when necessary.

Morning drop off:

Frontier Avenue

A number of you have used the Frontier Avenue area as a drop off area. This has worked very smoothly and has reduced the amount of traffic on Timbertop Avenue; we will continue to use and staff this as drop off area each morning.

Timbertop Avenue

This zone has become more fluid with each day and there has been a noticeable reduction in the level of congestion over the past week. For reasons of safety, to further increase the flow of traffic and reduce the time spent dropping off your child, we would encourage parents/guardians to:

- Refrain from completing a 'U-Turn' on Timbertop Avenue;
- Direct their children to cross at the temporary crossing when dropped off on the oval side of the road; and
- Work towards your child being the only one who gets out of the car at drop off so you are not parked in the fluid zones. Students should be getting out of the car on the gutter/footpath side of the car and should have their bags with them when exiting the car.

End of day pick up:

As of **Monday 26 October**, we will return to a 3:05pm finishing time for the <u>whole school</u> thus doing away with the staggered finishing times. Due to the number of parents/guardians parking and congregating at the gate in the afternoon, the staggered finishing time is of no benefit as it is not allowing for a fluid pick up arrangement. Students in Prep to Year 2 will be walked to the following designated areas:

- Prep: Collection will be on the school side of Timbertop Avenue travelling SOUTH;
- Years 1 and 2: Collection will be on the oval side of Timbertop Avenue travelling NORTH;
- Staff will arrange for siblings to be with students in Years Prep to Year 2;
- Could we ask that parents/guardians please wait at the designated areas for each given year level and ensure they
 observe social distancing expectations, if you have made other arrangements in regards to a meeting point with your
 child please alert you child's Classroom/TG teacher.

Camps Sports & Excursions Fund (CSEF) – Extended Eligibility Due Dates

This is applicable to families who hold a valid Centrelink Pensioner Concession or Health Care Card number (CRN).

In recognition of the impact of COVID-19 on schools and families, the Department of Education and Training (Vic DET) has extended the cut off date to apply for the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) in 2020.

Student ID Cards




