## **Bus Information**

#### Students sitting Unit 3 / 4 Exams

Public/Private buses are not recommended for students sitting Unit 3/4 exams which begin at 9.00am.

Students should always aim to arrive thirty minutes before the commencement of their examinations. The VCAA states that students arriving late will not be given allowance for reading time, and students arriving 30 minutes after the commencement of writing time may not have their responses accepted by the VCAA.

#### **Student ID Cards**

Many students are travelling on private buses without their student ID cards to tap on and off the bus. All students were given their Student ID cards at the start of the year. If your child/ren has/have misplaced their Student ID cards, students from Prep to Year 6 can have their parents write a note in their diaries advising their class teacher and a replacement will be printed by the ICT Department. Students in Years 7 to 12 can go to the ICT Department and ask for a replacement. Students who continually travel without their student ID cards will be sent to their Year Level Coordinator.


