DAY 13 COVID-19 TESTING INFORMATION

The Victorian Department of Health is working closely with your local public health unit and testing providers to ensure your community has streamlined and flexible Day 13 testing options.

Day 13 testing will commence on **Tuesday 27 July 2021** for most students and teachers. Refer to the guidance provided by Department of Health Public Health team on your exact Day 13 test.

Where can I get tested?

There are over 200 testing sites across Victoria where you can get tested for COVID-19. Refer to <u>Where to get tested</u> website for the most up-to-date testing locations, operating hours and wait times near you.

It is important you plan your day prior to getting tested.

You can expect moderate wait times depending on the testing site you choose. We have increased capacity to support local areas to help manage wait times. Please be patient with our staff.

Melbourne Showgrounds - priority access

Priority access will be made available at the Melbourne Showgrounds Drive Through site.

Please identify yourself as being from "Bacchus Marsh Grammar" to traffic staff when you arrive. The site is accessed via Gate 3, Langs Road, Ascot Vale and is open from 6.00am - 10.00pm.

You will receive prioritised access and can get tested anytime between 6.00am - 10.00pm.

Supporting local COVID-19 testing access

We recommend that those choosing to access testing locally within Moorabool Shire Council, Melton City Council and Wyndham Council, get tested within the recommended time slots.

Get through faster by pre-registering

To speed up information collection, please pre-register using **Test Tracker** - **Pre-fill Form** prior to arriving. Click on the <u>Pre-filltestingregistration form</u>, and you will receive a unique registration number via text message once complete. Present your unique registration number to our testing staff.

What to expect on the day?

How long are the wait times?

The Department of Health provide up to date testing site wait times and operating hours on the <u>Where to get tested</u> website. Please plan ahead prior to attending a testing site.

If sites become overwhelmed by demand, we may ask you to be diverted to other nearby sites.

Testing Schedule for Moorabool Shire, Melton and Wyndham LGA.

There are over 3000 primary close contracts to be tested on the day. Of which 90% reside in Melton, Moorabool and Wyndham LGA communities.

We are expecting increased demand and have added capacity through pop-up testing, additional staffing and priority testing at Melbourne Showgrounds.

Wherever practically possible, we encourage you follow the suggested testing times below to help reduce wait times at your local site. This is based on your year level and surname. Families with children in both Primary and Secondary school should attend once.

What to do after my test?

Continue to isolate regardless of your result

Go straight home and continue to isolate after your test. The Department of Health Public Health team will contact you and provide formal clearance from quarantine on Day 14.

How long will my result take?

As primary close contacts you will be given Priority 1 for pathology processing. This means you can expect your result within 24 hours via text message.
